A letter of recommendation, signed by the President of the sponsoring club, a membership roster with complete mailing addresses, this completed membership blank and a check for \$7.00 per member, made out to Texas Garden Clubs, Inc. should be mailed to the State Membership Chairman.
2. Newly federated garden clubs are eligible for District affiliation. However, a new club must first become affiliated with Texas Garden Clubs, Inc. before becoming a member of a District.
3. District membership is required to be in Good Standing with TGC, and to apply for Awards on any level (District, State, Regional, or National). District membership is encouraged because it will be advantageous, enabling new members, through association with members of experienced clubs to become more familiar with garden club work.
